Parents: This week continues with a sermon on the 7 deadly sins, specifically lust. It brings up topics of lust, love, and the impact of sexuality in our culture. It specifically brings up lust, sex, sexuality, and the pornography industry. The above sermon notes focus on the just story of Samson and his life. You can have your kids read or read to them the story of Samson and Delilah to answer the above questions. For those with older kids this could be a good opening to talk about lust and love.
