Thoughts to emphasize:

The Bible tells the story of God's people God loves his people and they worship Him The ABCs of Worship: Adore, Bow, Connect, Sacrifice

Bible Verse:

Isaiah 2:3 - "Come let us go up to the mountain of the Lord. He will teach us His ways, that we may walk in His paths."

Craft Center Activity

Let the children make an X-ray fish picture. Be sure that they do not color the fish - only the area around the fish. Color the fish bones black. If you "paint" the fish body with baby oil, the paper becomes more translucent, but even without that, you can hold up to the light to see the "x-ray" of the bones.

Supplies needed:

Fish pattern/bones pattern Crayons/tape or stapler Baby oil/cotton balls Paper towels

Snack Center Activity

Talk about how a doctor can see our bones with an x-ray, but how God can see and know everything about us. Let the children eat the "funny bone" snacks.

Funny bone snack


Worksheet Center Activity

What you will need: light weight computer printer paper (the cheaper the better), crayons, cooking oil or baby oil, paint brushes, paper towels, stapler or tape.




What to do:

- 1. Print out the X-ray Fish Pattern (PDF Pattern) and the x-ray fish Bones Pattern (PDF Pattern).






