Dear Parents,

We are excited to provide you with this curriculum and resources to help your child's spiritual formation. A team of Amy Cheesman, Christina Burchfield and Tonya Tennison and myself have worked diligently to put all age group packets together for you. It's been an overwhelming blessing to do so!!

It is our hope that you can use what is provided easily. We will be posting prompt's, help ideas on Tuesday mornings and reminders on Wednesday mornings on our PVKids FB page, please join if you haven't already, (this is a private group and you will have to request permission to join). We are treating this like Wednesday night Bible classes so all online resources will be ready on Wednesday BUT this is your class and your schedule! Have class when it is best for you!!

The curriculum is designed so that you can do the whole class in about 30-35 minutes, if you have multiple children doing multiple classes pick and choose what you would like to do or if its a hard night! We as teachers in the classroom realize that on any given night we might have to readjust so give yourself some grace when you need too.

Memory work and daily bible reading...suggestions on memory work is to put the verse in a place that your child will pass by a lot during their day, let them repeat it every time they see it, they will learn it quickly on their own.

Daily Bible reading suggestions -

- 1. place in the car door and read on the way to school each day, have a mini devo on the thought. Place beside their bed and read before prayers and going to sleep or*
- 2. place the Bible on the dinner table and read it all together and the pray.*

These suggestions helps the kids understand that they are having a conversation with God, God spoke to me through the reading of His Word and now I will speak to Him through prayer.

Please video your child saying their memory verse and post this on PVKids Facebook page. Remember to send in your child's video of them saying Ephesians 6: 13-17 or if the memorized the whole Armor of God passage Ephesians 6:10-24 by Halloween. You can place it on our FB page as well. This will encourage our kids and families; as well as earn them a special treat in their November resource package.

Also included is a suggested FAMILY ACTIVITY with this month being Thanksgiving we just added an activity to include your whole family at Thanksgiving.

This is my first time ever to develop a curriculum for home use!! And for you parents to not have a bible class teacher to back up your spiritual guidance. I want you to feel comfortable communicating with me the good and the bad. We are working on December packets, we can tweak this monthly!!

I'm praying for you and your family!! I love you and miss you!! We want this new chapter to be one that will grow you closer to God and each other.

Suggestion for Weekly Routine:

Point: For you to have in the back of your mind to make sure you talk about it during the lesson and during the week.

Memory Verse: Write the new memory verse on a sword. Place the sword somewhere you will see it multiple times a day. (Bathroom mirror, backdoor, car...) Have child repeat it every time they pass by it. This will help memorize it and place it in their heart and mind.

A.C.T.S. Prayer: Pray together using the A.C.T.S. of prayer guideline sheet provided. Some of your kids will remember this from class, some might need to be reminded and some will be learning it for the first time.. This is an excellent way to start teaching your kids to pray.
